One of the most scenic strolling gardens in the Hokuriku region, featuring the gently flowing Awazu River and colorful seasonal flowers throughout the year. Take a peaceful walk through the natural beauty of the garden at Mantenno Tsujinoya.



◆ “Tsujinoya” Afternoon Tea

Enjoy a refined afternoon tea in the garden lounge overlooking the grounds. Offerings include Kaga *bicha* (roasted stem tea) crème brûlée, homemade shortcake, and *temari-sushi*—bite-sized, ball-shaped sushi unique to traditional inns.

◆ Lobby Lounge

A serene space with views of the garden, offering a relaxing atmosphere for adult guests.



◆ Bar (Open irregularly)

Overlooking the illuminated garden at night, the bar serves both alcoholic and nonalcoholic beverages.

Unwind with our full-featured massage chairs and foot massagers, available free of charge throughout your stay.

A collection of 1,000 manga volumes is available to enjoy free of charge.



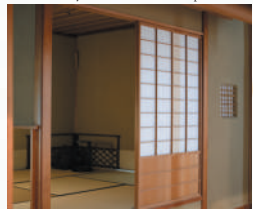
◆ Colorful Yukata Rental

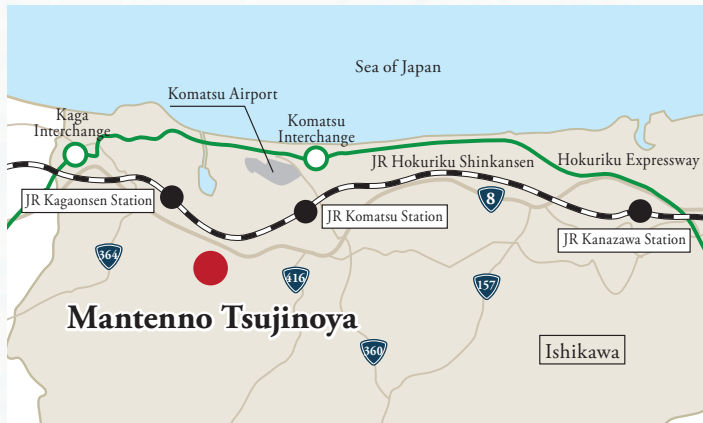

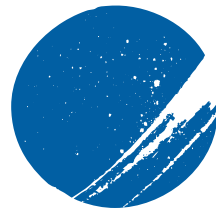

Guests staying in suites are served dinner and breakfast in private dining rooms. All other guests dine in our main dining hall.



Guest Rooms

We offer 56 guest rooms in 13 different styles, including suites, rooms with private open-air baths, and rooms equipped with three or four beds. All rooms feature beds with Simmons mattresses to ensure a restful and comfortable sleep.

Royal Suite

Our most luxurious accommodation, the Royal Suite includes a master bedroom with a view of the garden, a spacious living room with a large sofa set and 65-inch TV, a semi open-air bath, and a second bedroom. Enjoy complimentary minibar beverages, including alcoholic and soft drinks.



Family Suite

Uniquely equipped with full-size bunk beds—rare in traditional inns and hotels—this suite is ideal for families with children or multi-generational groups. The living room offers a beautiful view of the garden.



Suite with Private Open-Air Bath

This suite features a private open-air bath on the balcony. The spacious living area includes a sofa set and traditional legless chairs, and the wide *hiroen* (veranda) overlooks the garden.

A suite composed of a bedroom and a separate living area. All seven Junior Suites offer views of the garden.
